

Information about the processing of personal data

For filling system: Filling system – marketing

Information about the processing of data subject's personal data under Paragraph 19 and Paragraph 20 of the Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on Personal Data Protection and on the amendment of certain other Acts (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and Article 13 and 14 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation")

This information aims to provide knowledge about what personal data we process, how we deal with it, for which purposes we use it, to whom we can provide it, where you can obtain information about your personal data and enforce your rights in the processing of personal data.

1. Purpose of personal data processing and legal basis for processing

The purpose of the personal data processing is: marketing purposes (information about news, discounts and other marketing offers) including inclusion of personal data in the controller's database, offered products and services of the controller (advertising) and sent business announcements (newsletters).

Personal data are processed pursuant to point (f) of Article 6 (1) of the Regulation.

The legitimate interest of the Controller or third party

The processing of personal data for a purpose of the legitimate interests of the Controller is applied – making a marketing purposes.

2. Identification of processed personal data of the data subjects

Data subjects, whose personal data are processed are: clients/customers/potential customers.

The extent of processed personal data: title, name, surname, email address, telephone number and other data that the Data subject voluntarily add to the contact form for a published ad.

3. Identification of recipients, categories of recipients

The Controller may provide personal data to the authorized entities, such as institutions and organizations, under specific legal regulation or to the contractors (especially the data Processors) who have undertaken to accept reasonable safeguards for the protection of the processed personal data, as follows:

Personal data may be provided to other recipients if the data subject consents or orders to provide his/ her personal data to them.

4. Transfer of personal data to third country/international organization

The Controller transfers personal data to third countries, within the CBRE Group, Inc. Guarantees for the secure transfer of personal data to third countries are adopted in the form of standard contractual clauses concluded within the entire CBRE Group, Inc., pursuant to Art. 46 of the Regulation.

5. Identification of the source of which the data were collected

Directly from the Data subject (by an email, by a phone call, through the Controller's website) or through the website of the Joint controller (through the Joint controller's website).

6. The retention period of personal data

The Controller shall process the personal data for the period necessary to fulfill the purpose, however, no more than 5 years after the last request of the person concerned.

7. Profiling

The Controller does not process the personal data by profiling, or by other similar means based on automated individual decision-making.

8. Rights of the data subject

The data subject shall have the right to request from the Controller the access to processed personal data concerning him/her, the right to rectification of personal data, the right to personal data erasure or restriction, the right to object to the processing of personal data, the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, the right to data portability as well as the right to initiate the proceeding to supervisory authority. When the Controller processes the personal data based on data subject's consent, the data subject shall have the right to withdraw his or her consent to processing at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. The data subject can exercise his/her rights by sending an e-mail to e-mail address: sk.gdpr@cbre.com, or by sending the letter to the address of the Controller.

9. Obligation to provide personal data

The data subject provides his/her personal data voluntarily and is expected to be informed of the various marketing activities (news, discounts and other marketing offers) related to the purchased or acquired service or goods in the future. If they are not provided, they will not be informed about news, discounts or other marketing offers, nor will they be provided with the service or goods they procure.
